

Getting to and from CSU in Wagga Wagga



The CSU Wagga Wagga Campus is approximately 6.6 kilometres from the Wagga central business district (CBD). The walking route from the CBD (Morgan / Baylis Street intersection) to CSU is via North Wagga due to prohibited pedestrian access via the Gobbagombalin (Gobba) Bridge. Walking time from the CBD to CSU is approximately 1 hour 20 minutes and is marked on the map in this TAG.



BUSABOUT operates the bus services in Wagga Wagga. There are two BUSABOUT routes that service CSU Wagga Campus. The route numbers are:

Route 966 University & Estella to Wagga Wagga via North Wagga Wagga; and

Route 967 University & Estella to Wagga Wagga via Colin Knott Drive.

Route 966 is the most frequently operating and services the front entrance of CSU Wagga Campus on Boorooma Street. **Route 967** is less frequent and services the core campus of CSU, with bus stops at the front entrance on Boorooma Street, the Crow Bar (building **20**) on Darnell-Smith Drive, in front of the Mini-Mart on Valder Way, in front Hampden Residences on Bangala Way and the NaLSH (building **289**) on Nathan Cobb Drive.

Please have the exact fare ready as drivers have trouble changing notes. CSU students can travel at concession fares upon the presentation to the driver of an appropriate photo ID from CSU. Both services end in Central on Baylis Street. These services do not operate on Sunday or Public Holidays. Join other bus services at the Wagga Wagga City Centre where Route 966 and 967 terminate. CSU Wagga Campus is easily accessed by bicycle. There are two direct cycle routes from Central Wagga to CSU and a dedicated cycle route from the CBD to CSU via North Wagga. There is a shared-use path along Boorooma Street. The routes are marked on the map in this TAG. The CSU Wagga Campus is approximately 6.6 kilometres from the Wagga CBD (Morgan / Baylis Street intersection) via North Wagga Wagga to the main entrance of CSU on Boorooma Street. The average time this would take is 20 minutes. The cycle route from the CBD to CSU via the Gobba Bridge is 6.8 kilometres with an average trip time of 21 minutes.

Park/Ride/Shower facilities are located at the NaLSH (**289**), Cellar Door (**413**) and Jack Cross Centre (**15**). Bike parking hoops are located at buildings **13** (Library / Learning Commons front & back), **20** (The Hub Courtyard), **21** (School of Communications & Creative Industries), **26** (School of Humanities & Social Sciences), **229** (adjacent to the Food Bowl) and **268** (Sutherland Laboratories). Public shower facilities are available in buildings **279** (gym), and **20** (The Hub).

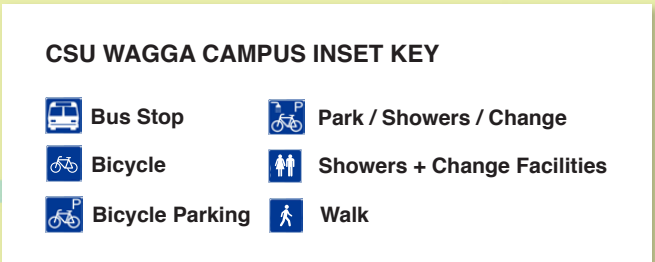
