Re: **Boorooma Street and Avocet Drive Intersection Upgrade – Update No.1**

I'm writing to give you a progress update on the construction of the new two lane roundabout at the intersection of Boorooma Street and Avocet Drive.

Key dates for the project have been identified and are as follows:

- **12 December to 23 December 2011** – Preliminary construction (with no road closures) is due to commence and will work up to the Christmas break.
- **3 January 2012** - Work will restart onsite (with no road closures) and continue through until mid January 2012
- **9 January 2012** – Road closures projected to come into effect. **Boorooma Street will be required to closed from the Olympic Highway Off ramp and Overpass from this date.** All traffic - excluding emergency and construction vehicles – which will be diverted (detour map on the reverse) to surrounding roads for the construction period. *Note: Message Boards will used closer to the time confirming the actual closure date.*

Council recognises the road closure for the duration of the project may cause some change and disruption to your normal travel routes, and to assist with this has instigated the following improvements to the diversion route:

- **Pine Gully Road / Estella Road Speed Reduction**  
For the duration of the diversion, Pine Gully Road from the Harris Road Intersection through to the Charles Sturt University and the whole of Estella Road will have a decreased speed restriction of 60km/hr in place
- **Farrer Road**  
Carriageway repairs and grading of the side drains will be undertaken prior to diversion coming into effect
- **Coolamon Road Farrer Road Intersection**  
Trees and vegetation will be removed from the eastern edge of Coolamon Road to the north of Farrer Road to improve sight distances at this intersection

Hours of construction will be as follows:

Monday to Friday - 6am to 6pm  
Saturday - 8am to 4pm  
Sunday / Public Holidays – No work

During the construction period, Busabout town service 964 and local school services will be affected by the road closures. New timetables for Town and School services for the period of the closures will be issued by Busabout shortly. More information will be supplied with future correspondence.

Council appreciates your co-operation and patience as we undertake this important enhancement to the road network.
