

Faculty of Business Honours Courses

Information for Students

The Faculty of Business has developed a new and exciting support model for students wishing to pursue an honours degree. The honours degree is an additional end-on 4th year to your undergraduate degree. The degree focuses upon developing research skills and producing an honour thesis on a research topic. Admission is open to full-time and part-time students and is available to those who have previously studied at Charles Sturt University and achieved at least a credit average or who have attained a similar qualification and standing from another University.

Research Topics

Financial Support

There will be a number of scholarships allocated on a competitive basis to support students. For **Australian domestic students** the benefits will consist of:

1. \$4,000 stipend (living allowance) scholarship from the University.
2. HECS exempt place from the University (a fee waiver, you don't have to pay tuition fees)
3. \$10,000 from the Faculty of Business in return for one day a week work (consisting of 28 weeks @ 7 hrs per week) as a Research Assistant for your supervisor (\$9,000 is available to cover living expenses and \$1,000 is available for research project costs)

The scholarships are available to both full time and part-time domestic students. Only the support as described in point 3) (\$10k from Faculty) is available to **international students**. **International students** are **not** eligible for the direct University support or fee waivers (points 1 and 2).
