FOR STUDENT CITIZENSHIP

Professor David Battersby was the Head of the Albury-Wodonga Campus from 2000 to December 2003. Professor Battersby was also the Deputy Vice-Chancellor of CSU until he became Vice Chancellor at The University of Ballarat in 2006.
