Students enrolled in their final year agriculture/agribusiness degrees at the Wagga Wagga and Orange Campuses are eligible for selection for the 2010 CBA AgriLine Scholarship offered through the Charles Sturt Foundation. VALUE: \$2000 upfront with \$2000 sign on bonus at the end of the year.

TENURE: One year

ELIGIBILITY: Students must:

- Be undertaking the final year of the Bachelor of Agricultural Science or Bachelor of Business degree (majoring in Agribusiness or Accounting, or have a rural background) at the Wagga Wagga Campus, or the Bachelor of Agricultural Business Management at the Orange Campus.
- Aspire to pursue a long term career in agribusiness finance.
- Have a sound academic record.
- Be passionate about Australian agriculture.
- Display a professional, collaborative and results driven approach.
- Have a strong customer focus.

SELECTION: Those students who meet the above criteria will be shortlisted by the University for an interview with CBA.

CONDITIONS:

- The full amount of the scholarship will be presented to the winner at the Scholarships Ceremony.
- An additional \$2,000 will be provided if the student is employed by CBA AgriLine at the completion of their studies.
- The recipient will have an opportunity to complete their practical experience component with CBA AgriLine.
