Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students enrolled either full time, part time, internal or by distance education, in their second or subsequent year of a Social Work/Social Welfare or Human Services degree at the Wagga Wagga Campus of Charles Sturt University are invited to apply for the 2010 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Human Services/Social Work Student scholarship.

VALUE: \$2,250

TENURE: One year

ELIGIBILITY: Students must:

- Be undertaking a degree in Social Work/Social Welfare or Human Services and be in their second or subsequent year, either full-time, part-time, internal or by distance education, on the Wagga Wagga Campus of Charles Sturt University;
- Provide a transcript showing sound academic performance;
- Have supporting documentation confirming proof of aboriginality.

SELECTION: Applicants should complete the 2010 Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship application form (excluding the questions on leadership, achievement and goals), enclosing copies of relevant supporting documents and addressing the eligibility requirements above. A one page letter explaining personal circumstances, financial situation, future goals and aspirations should be included.

CONDITIONS: \$1,125 will be presented to the winner after selection and the remaining \$1,125 at the beginning of Spring semester, subject to the student maintaining a pass grade point average in the preceding semester.
