MOREE PLAINS SHIRE COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP - 2010

- ELIGIBILITY:** First Year
- Bachelor of Education (Birth to 5 years)
Bachelor of Business (Finance)
Bachelor of Business (Human Resources Management)
Bachelor of Applied Science (Library and Information Studies)
- CAMPUS:** Any
- VALUE:** \$5,000 per annum for the duration of the course
- TENURE:** One year
- CONDITIONS:** Preference will be given in the first instance to a student who has an affinity with Moree Plains Shire. Students from Narrabri, Walgett, Gwydir and Goondiwindi Shire areas will also be considered. Supporting documentation such as a rate notice, energy account or school record is to be provided.
- The successful applicant must demonstrate a desire to work in the Local Government sector in a rural community.
- The successful student will be required to undertake a minimum of 4 weeks work experience at Moree Plains Shire Council at an agreed time. This will be paid employment and may exceed 4 weeks as agreed by the student and the Moree Plains Shire Council.
- The successful student will be required to meet the overall Foundation scholarship criteria of academic merit, leadership and motivation and achieving a credit grade point average.
- Half the value of the scholarship will be presented at the scholarship ceremony with the balance payable at the beginning of second semester providing a grade point average of 5 or above is achieved and enrolment is ongoing.
- HOW TO APPLY:** Applicants should complete the Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include copies of relevant supporting documents.
- NOTE:** Only one on-line Scholarship Application Form should be completed. During submission of your on-line application you should select all the scholarships that you wish to apply for and for which you meet the selection criteria.
