- Demonstrate a commitment to rural practice.

Selection: Applicants should complete the 2010 Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include results of the Higher School Certificate examination, copies of the most recent academic records and references, and a statement outlining why they should be considered for this scholarship.

Conditions: \$2,000 payment after selection.

Upon completion of the Degree, the winners will be interviewed for entry into the Graduate Nurse Transition Program at Calvary Health Care Riverina.
