



# REBECCA ANN FISH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Students enrolled in an undergraduate program at Charles Sturt University or other Australian or International university that would upon completion make them eligible for enrolment in the Bachelor of Business (Honours) course at Charles Sturt University in one of the following fields of study: International Human Resource Management, Human Resource Management or Cross-Cultural Management – are invited to apply for the Rebecca Ann Fish Memorial Scholarship offered through the Charles Sturt Foundation.

**VALUE:** \$1,000.

**TENURE:** One year.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

1. The scholarship may be awarded to either a domestic OR an international student.
2. Sound academic performance in the candidate's undergraduate program.
3. A preliminary honours program proposal not exceeding 500 words that provides information as to:
  - (i) The intended field of research, i.e. International Human Resource Management, Human Resource Management or Cross-Cultural Management.
  - (ii) The research issue the candidate wishes to investigate.
  - (iii) Why the issue is worthy of investigation.
  - (iv) The potential benefits to be derived from determining an answer to the research issue.
4. Demonstration of an important community or University contribution(s). For example, participating as a committee member of a recognised community organisation. Alternatively, participating as a student representative on a University committee.
5. Demonstration of a sound extra-curricular or sporting achievement.
6. Demonstration of a considered personal career plan and objectives.

**SELECTION:** Applicants should complete the 2010 Charles Sturt Foundation scholarship application form and include certified copies of relevant documents.

**CONDITIONS:**

1. \$500 shall be presented to the winner after selection. The remaining \$500 shall be presented upon the student maintaining a credit grade point average in the coursework component and approval of the student's research proposal.
2. The successful applicant will be required to be based at the Wagga Wagga Campus on a full-time basis.
