



WAGGA WAGGA LALC AND ABORIGINAL COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

Indigenous students enrolled in any year of any undergraduate degree at the Wagga Wagga Campus of Charles Sturt University are invited to apply for the 2010 Wagga Wagga Local Aboriginal Land Council and Aboriginal Community Scholarship.

VALUE: Two scholarships valued at \$3,500 each

TENURE: One year

ELIGIBILITY: Students must:

- Be a resident of the Wagga Wagga Local Aboriginal Land Council boundaries;
- Be undertaking any degree, either full-time, part-time or by distance education, on the Wagga Wagga Campus of Charles Sturt University;
- Have a sound academic record;
- Be able to demonstrate financial need;
- Have confirmation of Aboriginality.

SELECTION: Applicants should complete the 2010 Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship application form (excluding the questions on leadership, achievement and goals), enclosing copies of relevant supporting documents and addressing the eligibility requirements above. A one page letter explaining personal circumstances, financial situation, future goals (including Koori Community involvement) and aspirations should be included.

CONDITIONS: \$1,750 will be presented to the winner after selection and the remaining \$1,750 at the beginning of Spring semester, subject to the student maintaining a credit grade point average in the preceding semester.
