VALUE: \$1,500.

TENURE: One year.

ELIGIBILITY: Students must:

- Be able to demonstrate financial need;
- Have a sound academic record.

SELECTION: Applicants should complete the 2010 Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship application form and include copies of relevant supporting documents. Applicants should also provide details of genuine need for financial assistance by completing the [Hardship/Disability form](#).

CONDITIONS: \$750 will be presented to the Scholarship winner after selection and the remaining \$750 at the beginning of Spring Session, subject to the student maintaining a credit grade point average in the preceding session.

The successful applicant must attend one Sunrise Rotary meeting during the second semester to be the guest speaker. Meetings are on Tuesdays at 7.20am and finish at 8.30am.
