TEMORA SHIRE COUNCIL/IZUMIZAKI SCHOLARSHIP

Maximum of Two Scholarships valued at \$1,500 each

Students who will be enrolled in any year of an agriculture-related course at Charles Sturt University Wagga Wagga in 2010 are invited to apply for the Temora Shire Council/Izumizaki Scholarship.

VALUE: Maximum of two scholarships valued at \$1,500 each.

TENURE: One Year.

ELIGIBILITY: You are eligible to apply if:

- You reside within the Temora Shire boundaries, or
- Your parents reside within the Temora Shire Boundaries, or
- You completed the HSC at a school in the Temora Shire Council area.

Applicants should also possess a sound academic record, and be able to demonstrate a significant contribution to School or community activities.

SELECTION: Applicants should complete the 2010 Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form, attaching copies of relevant documents.

CONDITIONS: \$750 will be presented to each Scholarship winner after selection and the remaining \$750 at the beginning of the Spring Semester, subject to satisfactory academic performance.
