## **Division 1 Introduction**

### **1 Name of Rule**

This Rule is the *Governance (Official Emblems) Rule 2008*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Rule commences on 21 February 2008 (CNL08/11).

### **3 Purpose**

A Rule for the purpose of defining the official emblems of the University.

### **4 Authority**

This Rule is made pursuant to authority granted to the Council under section 31 (1) (f) and 32 of the Act.

#### **Notes**

Section 31 (1) (f) and 32 of the Act states that the Council may make Rules with respect to governance and administration of the University.

### **5 Definitions**

Words defined in the Act or By-law have the corresponding meaning in this Rule unless otherwise stated.

### **6 Notes and Headings**

- (1) The notes in the text of this Rule do not form part of this Rule.
- (2) Headings do not form part of this Rule.

## **Division 2 Official Emblems**

### **7 Official Motto**

The official motto of the University is 'For the Public Good'.

### **8 Official Floral Emblem**

- (1) The official floral emblem of the University is the Sturt Desert Pea or *Swainsona Formosa*.
- (2) The official floral emblem is a graphic representation of the Sturt Desert Pea outlined in Black and filled in CSU Red (Pantone 200C) as shown at Item 1 of Schedule 1.

### **9 Official Arms**

The official arms of the University (or shield) is as shown at Item 2 of Schedule 1 and consists of the following elements on a shield of CSU Grey (Pantone 423C):

- (a) an open book in black outline in a white background reflecting the traditional role of a University to promote scholarship, research, free inquiry, the interaction of research and teaching, and academic excellence, and
- (b) three waves in CSU Blue (Pantone 286C) depicting the three Australian rivers, the Macquarie, Murrumbidgee and Murray rivers, all of which were explored by Charles Napier Sturt, support the economies and communities of inland NSW and flow through the campus cities of Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo and Wagga Wagga, and
- (c) the floral emblem of the University in CSU Red (Pantone 199C) outlined in black.

## **10 Coat of Arms**

- (1) The armorial bearings of the University is shown at Item 3 of Schedule 1 and consists of the following elements:
  - (a) the official arms of the University at the centre,
  - (b) a helm positioned above the arms showing a knight's helmet crowned with three golden stars above which sits the crest – a lion holding three keys,
  - (c) mantling dressed in green and gold at either side of the helm and arms, and
  - (d) a motto scroll inscribed with the official motto at the base of the arms.

## **11 Flag**

- (1) The University flag is a single and reverse vertical tricolour as shown at Item 4 of Schedule 1.
- (2) The flag has a hoist dimension of 1.0 to a fly dimension of 2.0 (double square).
- (3) The hoist side is a field of CSU Grey (Pantone 423C).
- (4) The mid-field is a thin stripe in Pantone White separating the hoist side and the fly side colours.
- (5) The fly side is CSU Red (Pantone 200C) with the charge (Official Arms) in Pantone White positioned in the centre of the field.
- (6) The proportional dimensions are 18:2:80.
- (7) For ceremonial purposes, the Official Flag may be lined with a gold tassel of no more than 30 millimeters around each edge.

## Division 3 General

### 12 Precedence

For the avoidance of doubt, the image of an official emblems contained in Schedule 1 are the correct rendering of the official emblems of the University and where there is an inconsistency between the description provided in this Rule and the image the form set out in Schedule 1 prevails.

### 13 Delegations

- (1) The Vice-Chancellor may approve, from time to time, policies and procedures with respect to the form and use of the official floral emblem, official motto and official shield.
- (2) The Council may approve policies with respect to the use of the Official Flag and Coat of Arms.
- (3) The Coat-of-Arms will be reserved for use in relation to the functions of Council or its officeholders or otherwise as approved by the Secretary.
