


## CSU Interact: Copyright Compliance site

The "Copyright Compliance" site in CSU Interact explains how resources can be supplied to students of the University for their educational purposes. The terms and conditions of the CAL licence for the use of print and graphic materials, Screenrights licence for the use of audiovisual materials, music licence, database and eBook licences. It is highly recommended that all new academic staff complete the training.



In order to nominate for the training you will need to log into Web Kiosk. Under **Skills & Development** click on **Training Nomination; View Available Courses; WEBP – Work Effectively – Business Processes - Online; L0035 – Online Copyright Compliance**; and then nominate.

You then need to add it to your list of CSU Interact sites by following the instructions below:

- Log in to [CSU Interact](#).
- Click on the "Membership" link in the left-hand navigation menu.
- Click on "Joinable Sites" at the top of the membership window.
- Type "Copyright Compliance" into the search box on the right and click "Search".
- Click on "Join" under "Copyright Compliance" in the search list.
- The Copyright Compliance site will now appear in your list of CSU Interact sites.
