

# Bachelor of Arts (Acting for Screen and Stage) Applicants

---

Applicants for the Bachelor of Arts (Acting for Screen and Stage) course are required to attend an audition/interview to assist in the assessment of their application.

You will be required to:

Arrive half an hour before your audition time. This will give you time to warm up and relax. Please wear loose, comfortable clothing that allows you to move freely. You will be required at the audition for about 90 minutes (not all day).

The audition will consist of;

**Monologue Presentation** - please refer to Information on Monologues, in the audition booklet.

**Interview** – this will be a brief and informal interview that will last approximately 10 minutes. The purpose is to discover a little more about your ambitions and interests and for you to ask any questions you may have about the course.

*If you are unable to attend an audition/interview, you may apply by submitting a video:*

**Video** - Please note that if you are auditioning via video, Mini DV or DVD can be used and you may also be contacted by phone for an interview.
