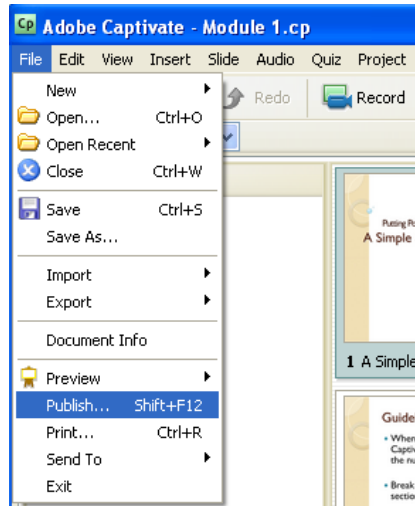


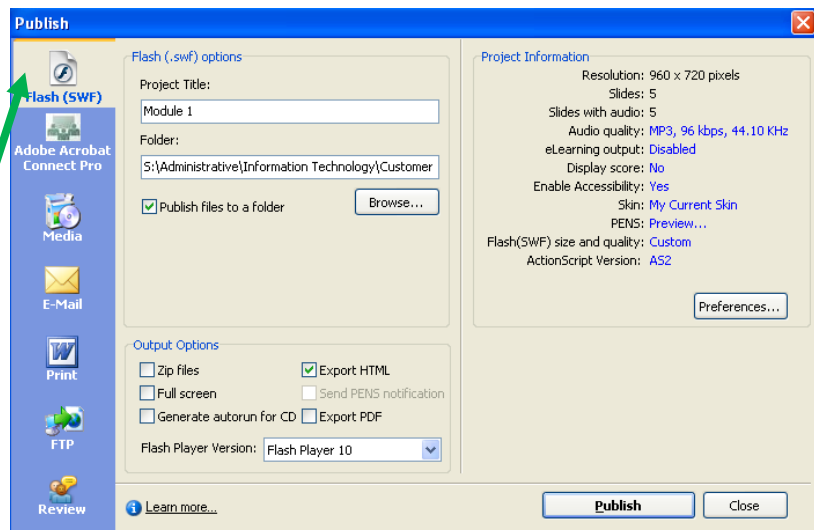
Publishing Flash projects

Publish a Flash File

- go to File> Publish



- The Publish dialog box opens



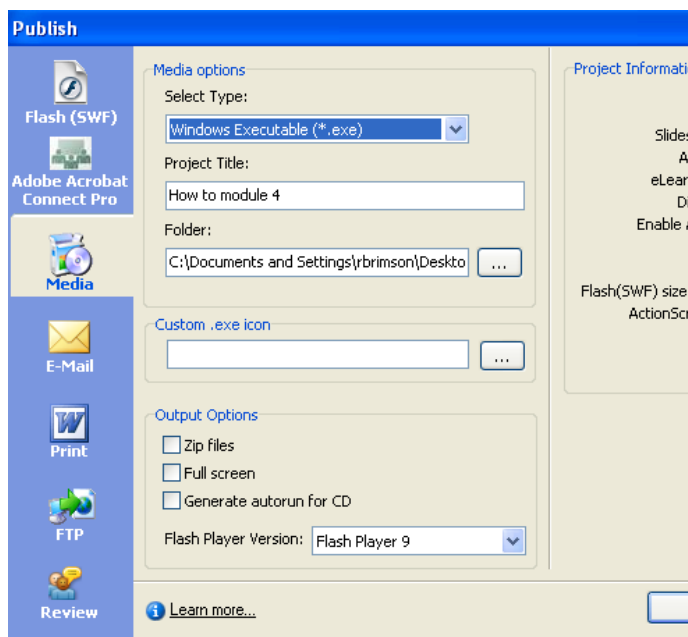
- select Flash (SWF) from the list at the left
- change the project Title to a meaningful name
- click the Browse button
- navigate to where you want to save the published files
- make sure Export **HTML** is checked
- click OK
- click Publish
- click View Output
- Your project will now play in a web browser.

Publishing a file in a video format

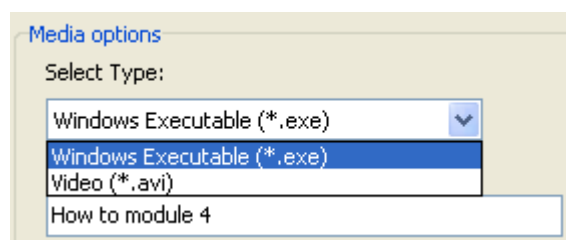
There are going to be times when you only want someone to see the video and not interact with it. You can publish your Captivate as a video file and not a “Flash” file. Here are the steps to do this.

WARNING! This will get rid of any interactivity in your Captivate.

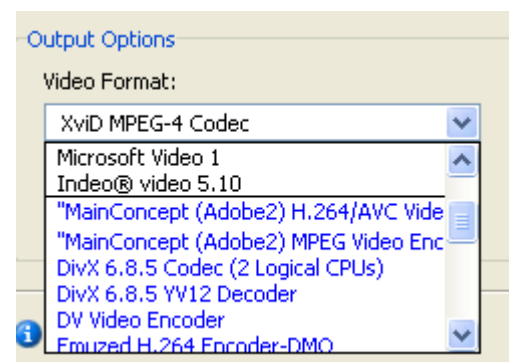
- Click Publish
- Select “Media”



- In the “Select Type” dropdown box, select “Video (*.avi)”



- In the “Folder” text box, navigate to where you want to save it.
- In the Output Options, Video Format box, select the codec of your choice



- Leave the Audio Format as PCM
- Then click Publish

Note: there will be a large preview box that will appear, wait until your movie has played all the way through and at the end it will make a video in the location that you specified.
