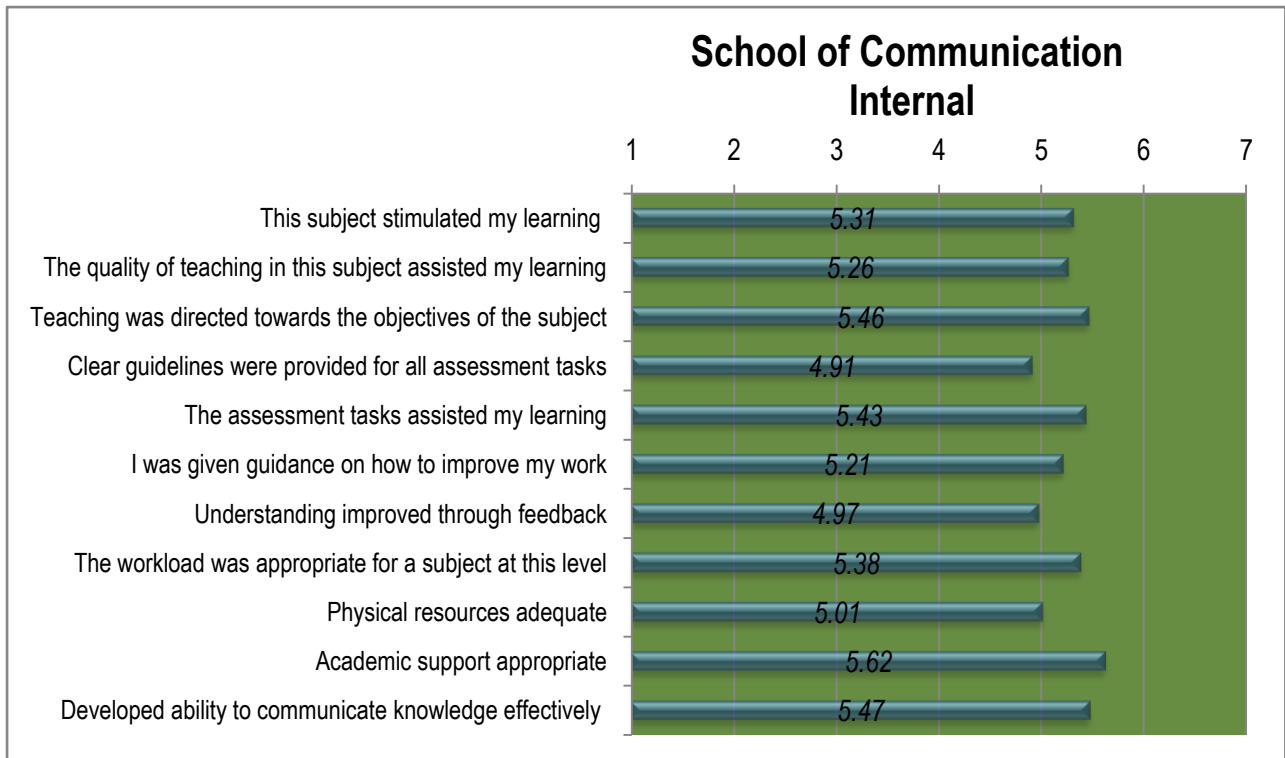

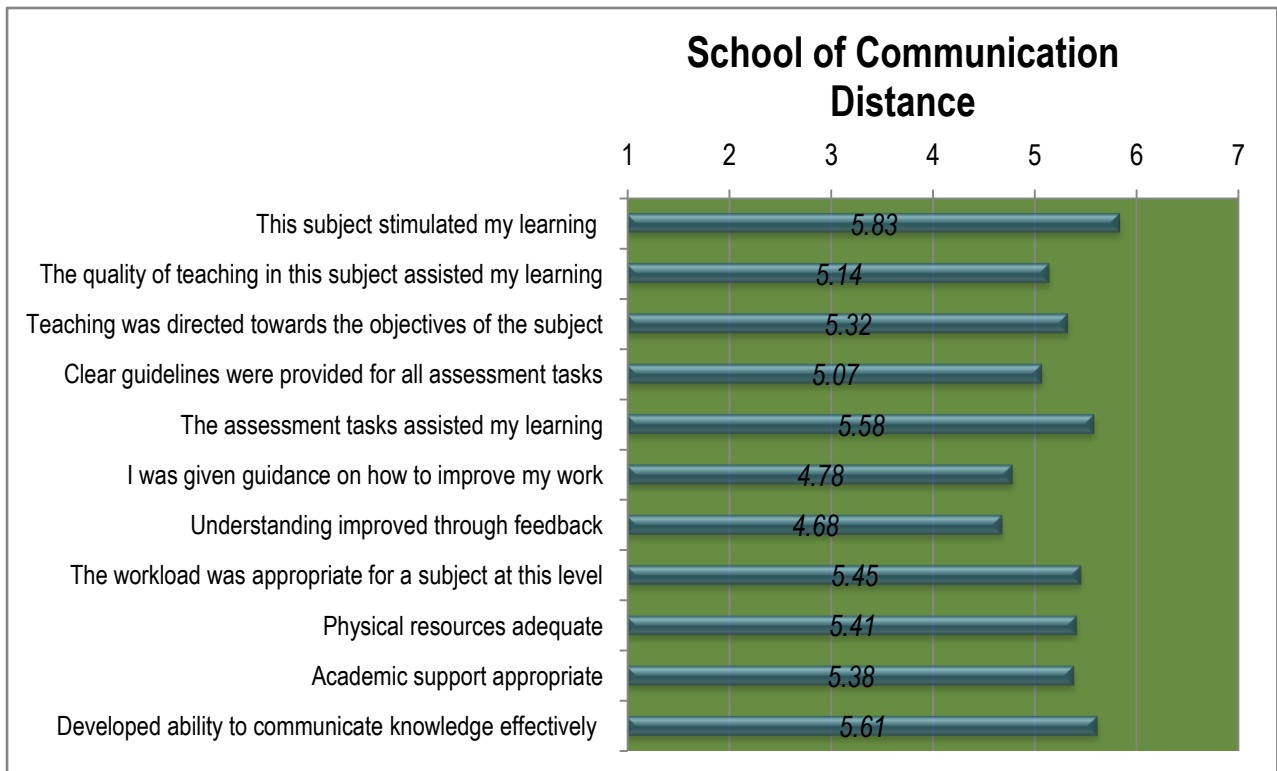

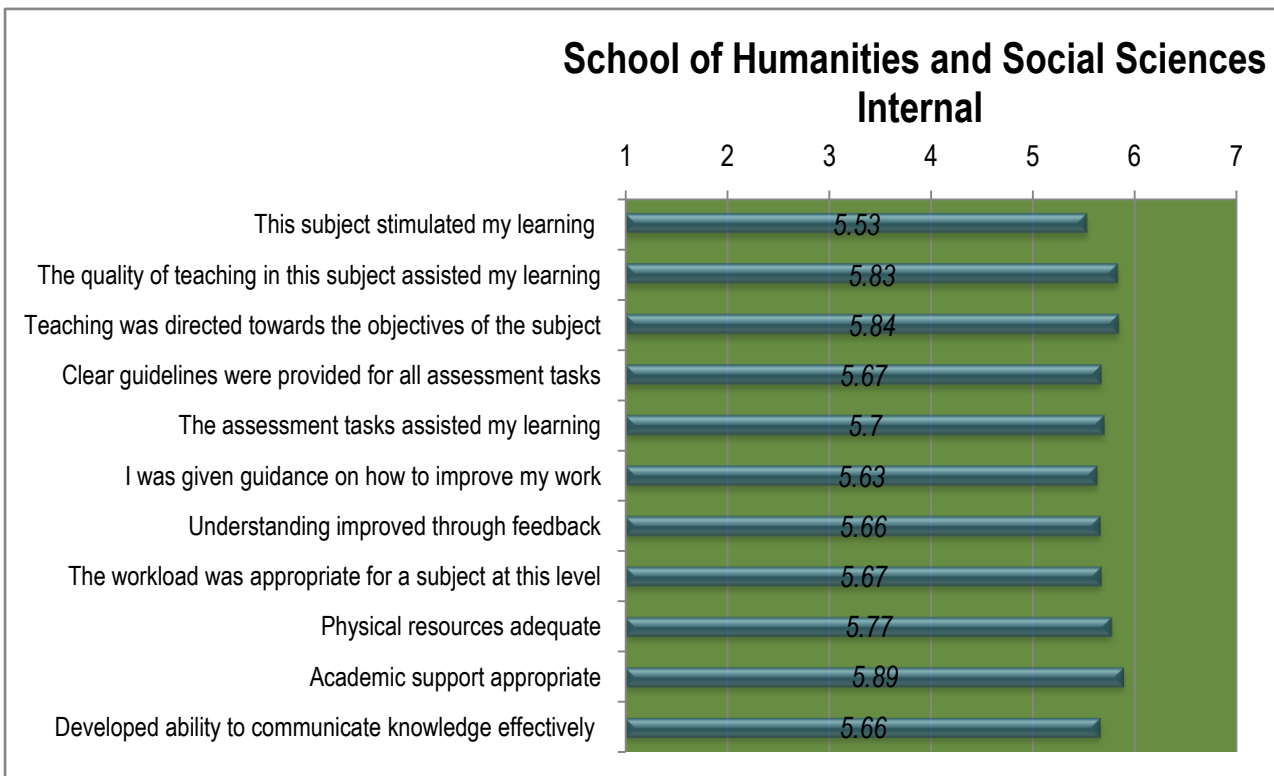

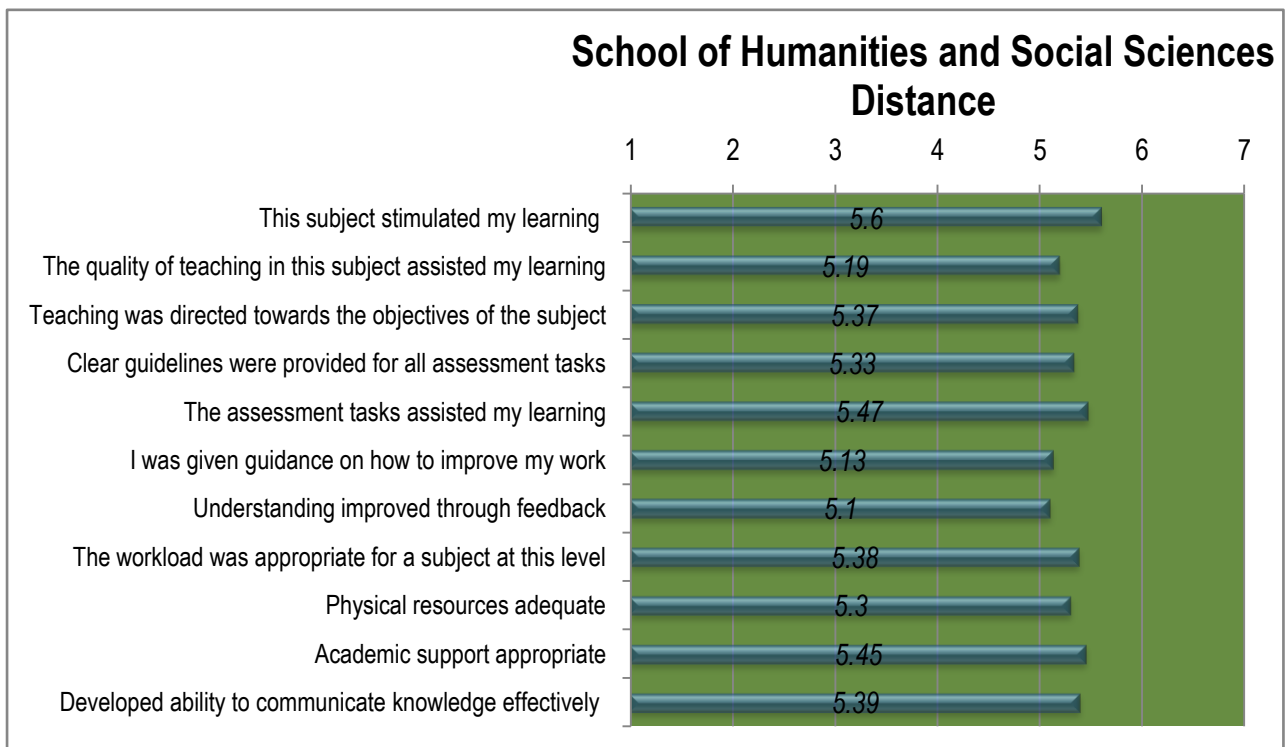
School of Communication (Internal) Response Percentage 13%



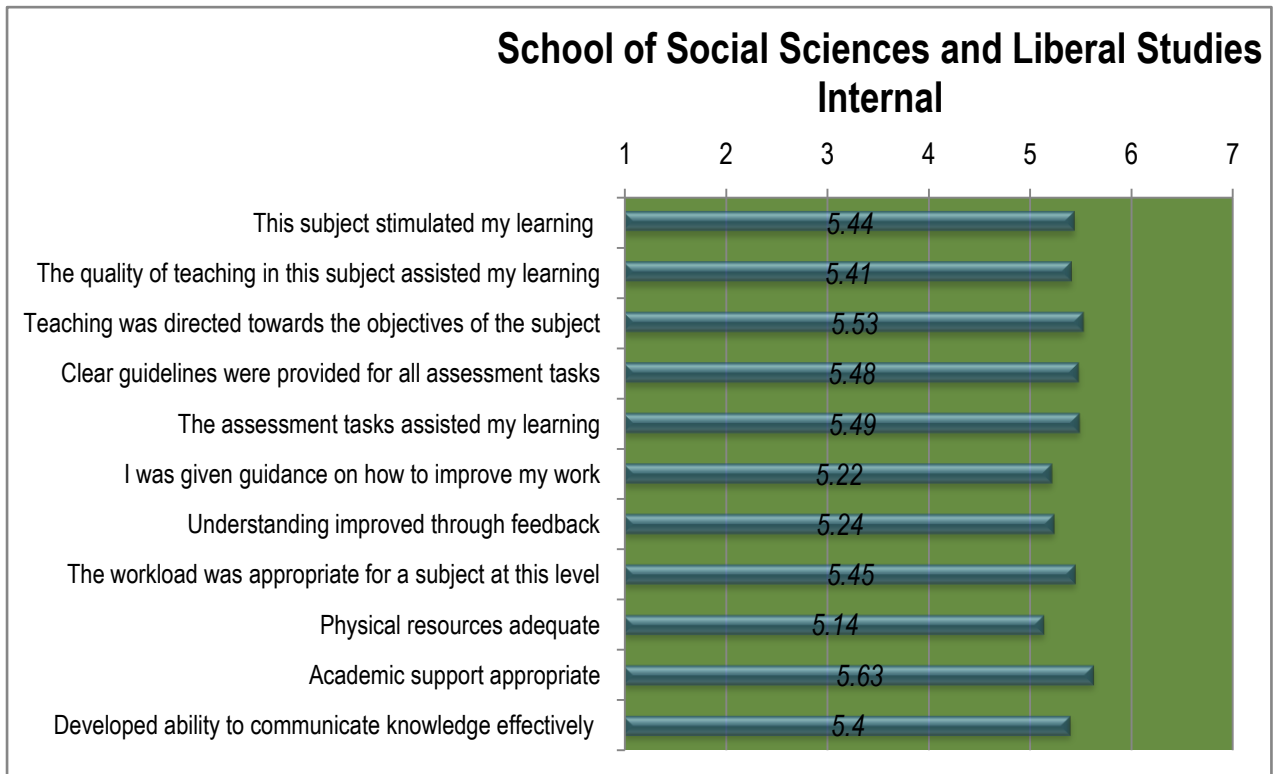
School of Communication (Distance) Response Percentage 29%



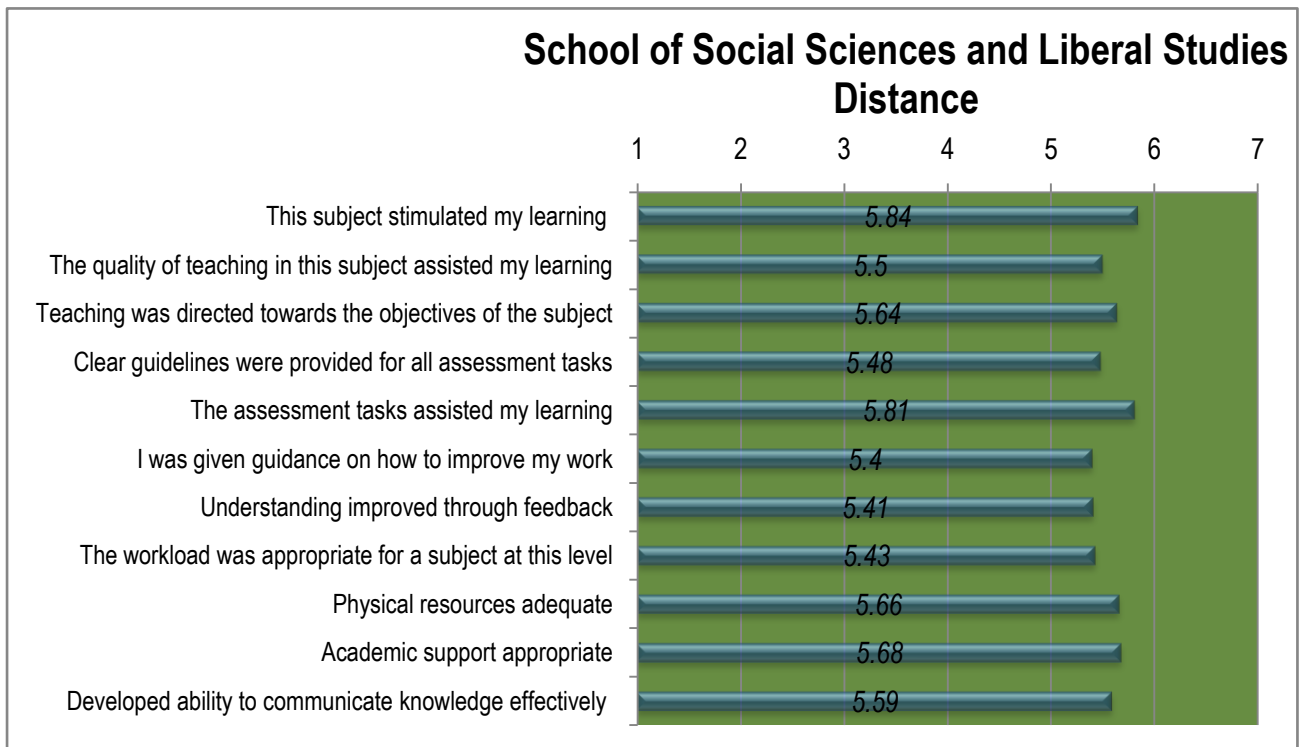
School of Humanities & Social Sciences (Internal) Response Percentage 30%



School of Humanities & Social Sciences (Distance) Response Percentage 26%

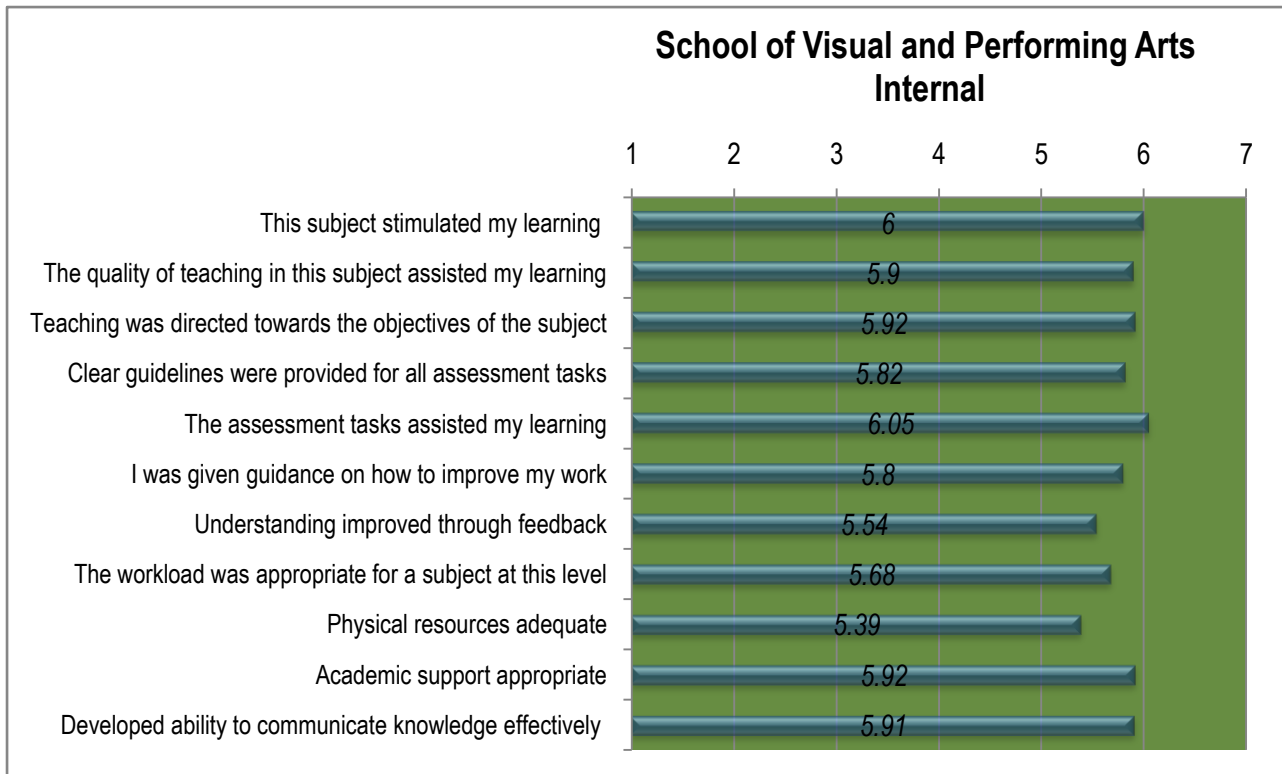


School of Social Sciences & Liberal Studies (Internal) Response Percentage 20%

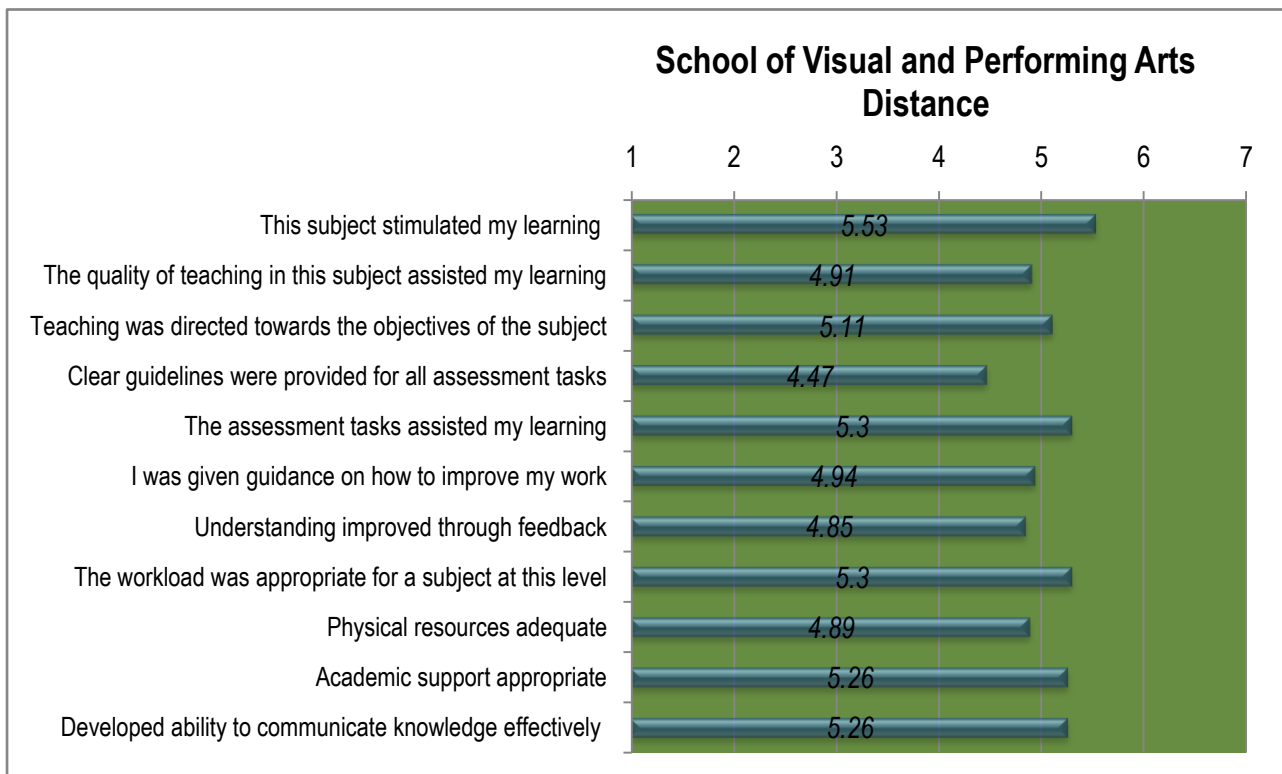


School of Social Sciences & Liberal Studies (Distance) Response Percentage 27%

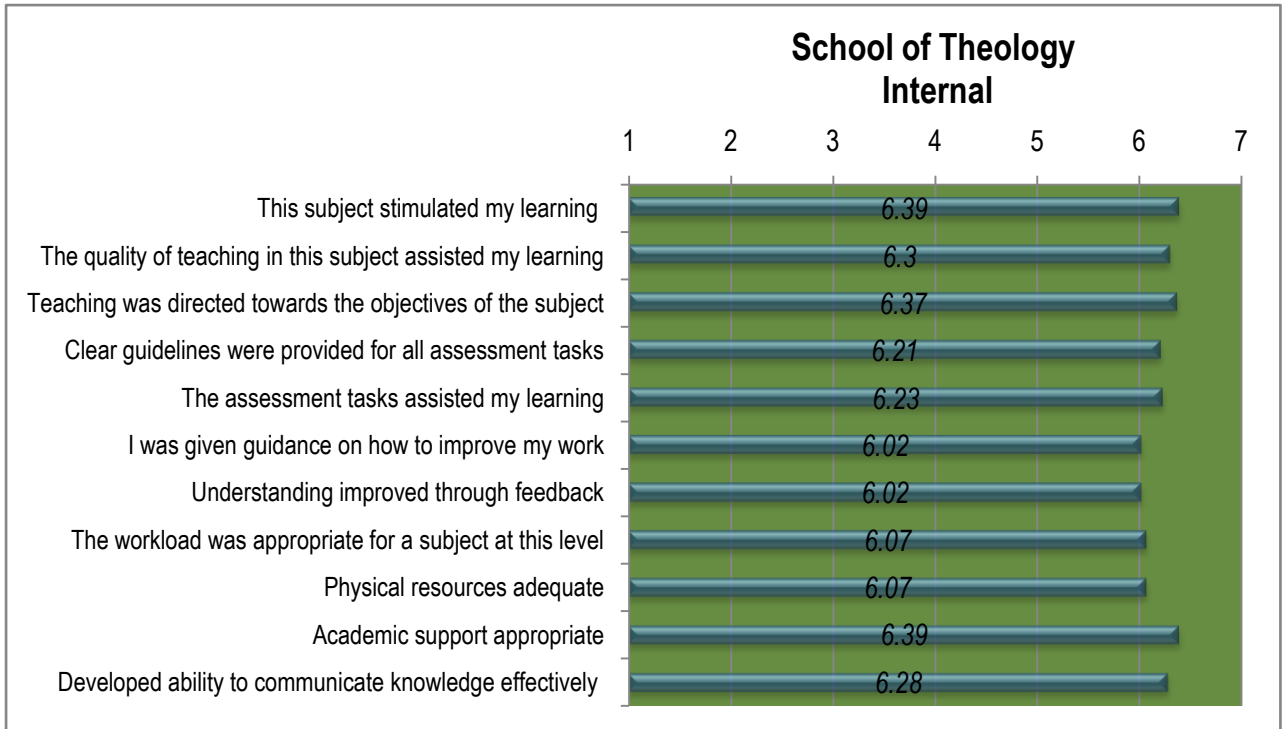


School of Visual & Performing Arts (Internal) Response Percentage 21%

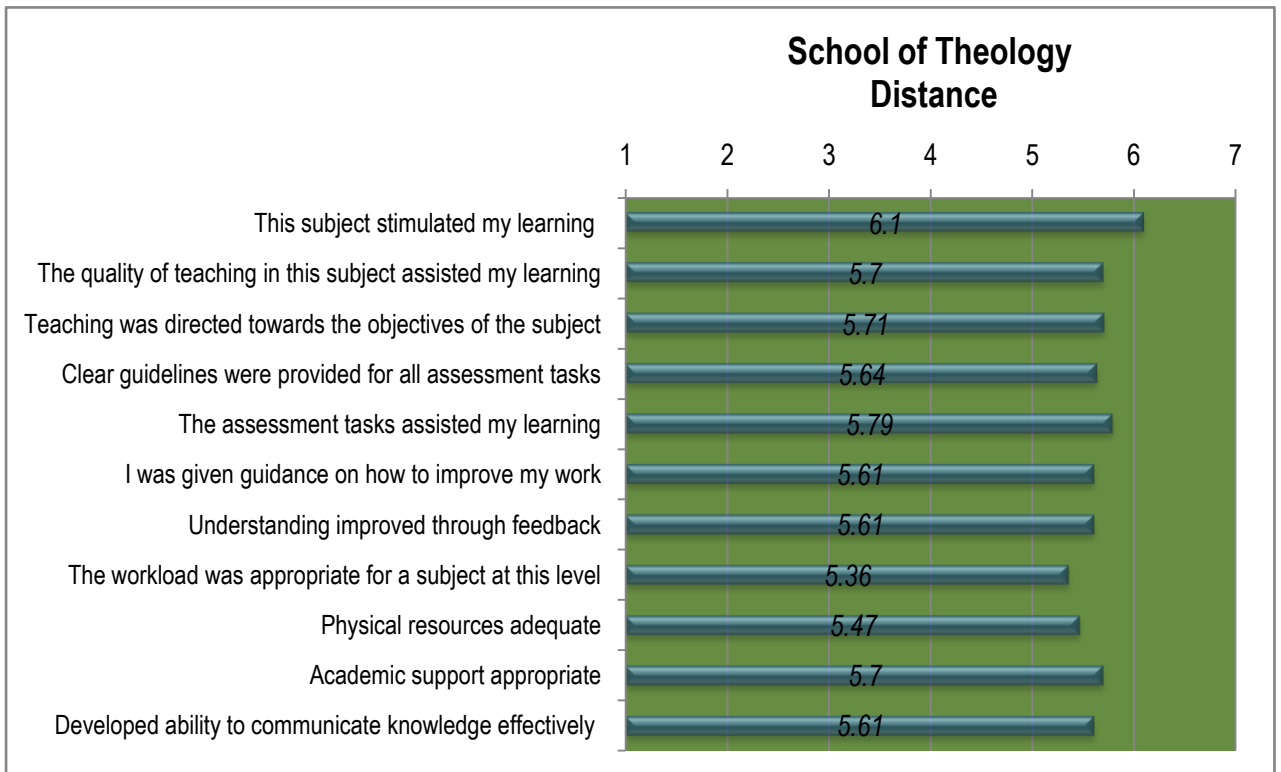


School of Visual & Performing Arts (Distance) Response Percentage 24%

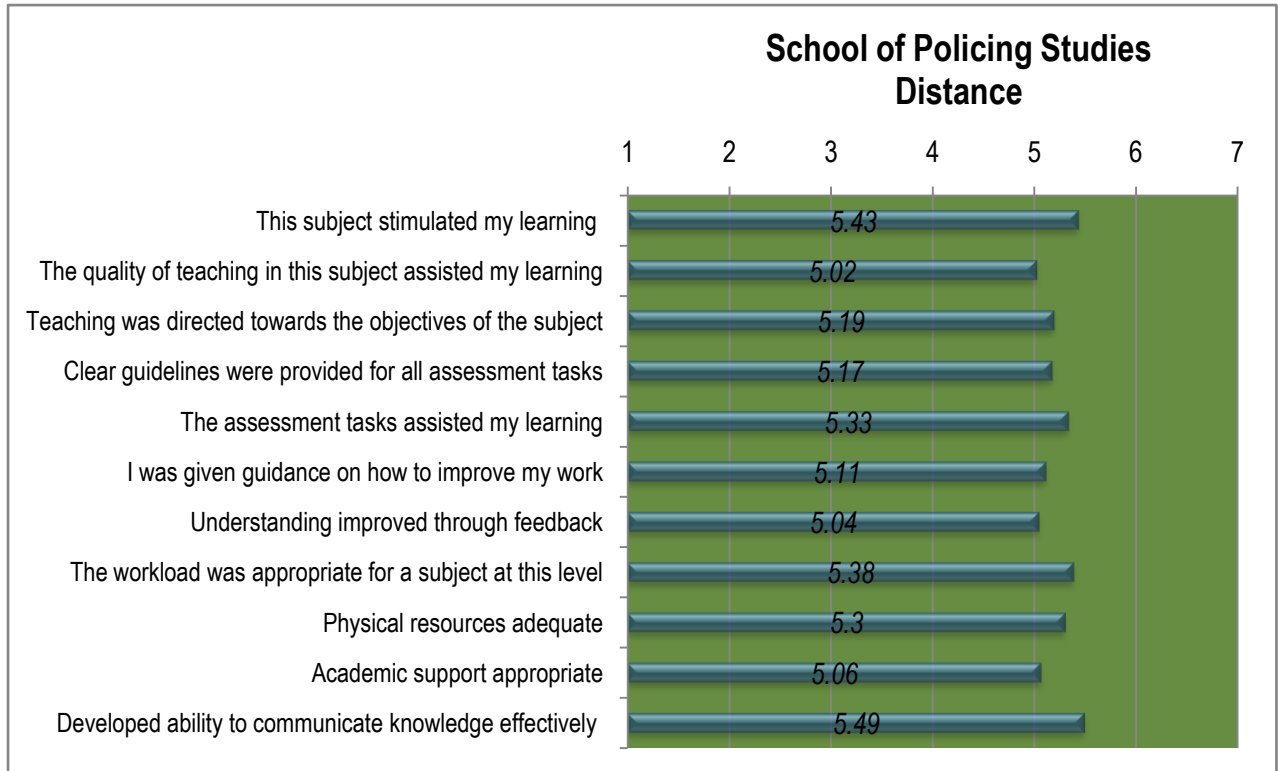


School of Theology (Internal) Response Percentage 23%

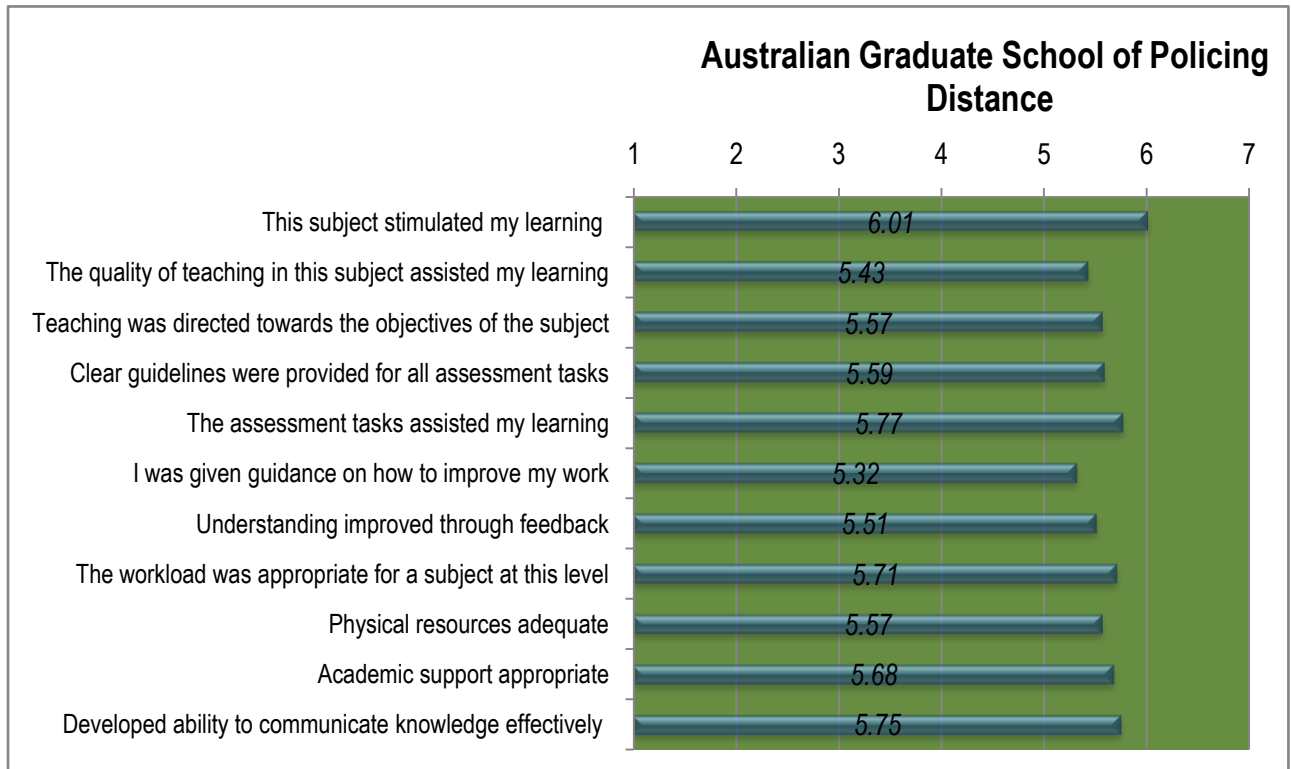


School of Theology (Distance) Response Percentage 33%
