

Modules Hints & Tips - February 2009

Import/export of Modules – a technical error associated with the import/export of modules has been repaired (Feb. 25 2009). The error was related to corruption of the zip file during the export process. Users wanting to import zip files that were exported prior to the system repair are advised to re-export the Modules before trying to import the zip file into another site.

An easy way to transfer modules from one site you own to another site you own is to use the site Info > Import from Site > function whereby you can select the site you own and what material you wish to copy across to another site.

Sferyx

Security certificate – Feb. 2009 When installing Sferyx you may receive an error message saying the security certificate is out of date. This is a licence issue and is being looked into but does not pose a major threat to computer security and users can safely continue installation. Don't forget that for Sferyx to work you need the java installation as per instructions in Help site.

Display of Modules – users are experiencing problems associated display of default fonts in Modules, mainly associated with the FCK editor, IE6 and IE 7 browsers and Microsoft Word formatting problems. There are a number of workarounds to minimise this:

1. Use the Mozilla firefox browser to display modules
2. Minimise formatting issues by careful use of cut and paste from Word.
 - a. Save word docs. as rtf format before cut & paste
 - b. Use the Word paste function in the Modules editor to clean up text.
