

ORIENTATION LEADERS RECRUITMENT

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

Students commencing study require accurate information, support and guidance from senior students who are approachable and sensitive to the needs of new students. Orientation Leaders can make a very real difference to how well new students settle into university and study.

Among the commencing students there is a diversity of people to be assisted and supported including mature-age students, school-leavers, international students, and students with disabilities.

Interpersonal skills, communication skills, and the necessary sensitivity for understanding the needs of fellow students are the required and essential attributes for the available positions.

Leaders will be required to undertake Orientation training as well as return the weekend prior to Orientation to assist with organisation and set up for the week.

ORIENTATION LEADERS

There are a number of Orientation Leaders positions available to interested students. These positions will assist and support the coordinators by undertaking various tasks and activities to bring about a successful Orientation week. They will work as part of a team and provide essential information and guidance to new students during the Orientation programme.
