In the event that no suitable applications were received from commencing students, then continuing students would be considered, at the discretion of the University.

Selection: Applicants should complete the 2010 Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application form and enclose copies of relevant supporting documentation addressing the eligibility requirements.

Conditions: \$1,000 will be presented to the winner at the Scholarships Ceremony.
