This Honours Degree program, developed in partnership with faculty from the Early Childhood Programs at Mohawk and Sheridan, is offered at Charles Sturt University's Burlington, ON campus.

PROGRAM DETAILS

An exciting new program with an international focus, delivered by a combination of Australian and Ontario early childhood academic faculty

- Applicants who qualify (successful completion of an Ontario Diploma in Early Childhood Education with a B average) are granted full recognition for their two year diploma
- Four year Honours Degree can then be completed in only two additional years
- Degree has been approved by the Ontario Ministry of Training Colleges and Universities
- Graduates are well placed to move into leadership roles in a variety of early childhood services in Ontario, they are also qualified to enter a faculty of education program to obtain elementary teacher qualifications.
- Both full time and part time options are available.
- Flexible schedule allows students to continue working if necessary
- Enrolment is limited to 50 students per year.
