1. Admission criteria

Applicants

- ❖ must hold a degree which includes a three-year major in psychology accredited by the Australian Psychological Society completed within the last five years
- ❖ must have completed PSY301 Advanced Research Methods and Statistics in Psychology, or its equivalent; and
- ❖ must have a GPA of 5.5 or better in level 2 and 3 APS major psychology subjects.

2. Psychology Major

Applicants must provide evidence that the qualification that they have completed contains an Australian Psychological Society (APS) accredited major in Psychology.

This can be done by providing a letter from your institution of study confirming that the course you have completed contains an APS accredited major and that you are eligible to apply for fourth year programs.

If you are not certain whether your study in Psychology was accredited as a three-year major by the APS you may check with the Australian Psychological Society, 1 Grattam Street, PO Box 126, Carlton South, Victoria, 3053 (telephone 03 96636166).
