The Graduate Certificate in Paramedic Service Leadership and Management is designed for practicing and aspiring paramedic service managers who seek formal qualifications to complement their paramedic experience and qualifications. The course provides an international perspective and focuses on paramedic services systems, leadership, professional identity and evidence-based management. Graduates have a fundamental understanding of major aspects of the leadership and management role as it applies to the delivery of pre-hospital medical care and will have developed the managerial competencies of graduates by equipping them with the knowledge and skills necessary to facilitate effective and efficient practice at personal, professional and organisational levels.
