Graduate Certificate in University Leadership and Management

The aim of this course is to enhance the capacity of participants to undertake leadership and management roles and responsibilities in a university. The course emphasises the leadership aspect of management to develop self-aware and reflective practitioners. The course explores various conceptualisations of leadership inviting participants to articulate their own leadership values and philosophy in alignment with CSUs strategic mission. Theoretical perspectives on university governance and strategic management emphasise strategic thinking, analysis and action to assist participants in developing practical, but theoretically sound, project plans in order to accomplish their leadership.
