The Graduate Diploma of Organisational Coaching and Leadership is jointly offered by Charles Sturt University and the Institute of Executive Coaching and Leadership. The course combines academic study with industry accredited coaching training to provide knowledge and skills in coaching and leading high-performing, dynamic organisations. The course is structured to help graduates develop reflective and critical judgement, problem solving, cultural competence, ethical decision making and effective communication and facilitation skills. The IECL component of the course provides Accredited Coach Training Program (ACTP) certification and eligibility to apply for International Coach Federation (ICF) credentials.

The Graduate Certificate in Organisational Coaching and Leadership is jointly offered by Charles Sturt University and the Institute of Executive Coaching and Leadership. The course combines academic study with industry accredited coaching training to provide knowledge and skills in coaching and leading high-performing, dynamic organisations. The course is structured to help graduates develop reflective judgement, problem solving, ethical decision making and effective communication skills. The IECL component of the course forms part of the Accredited Coach Training Program (ACTP) and provides a pathway to ACTP certification and International Coach Federation (ICF) credentialing.

Applicants without a tertiary qualification may be admitted to the Graduate Certificate in Organisational Coaching and Leadership on the basis of professional attainment and/or work experience. Upon successful completion of the Graduate Certificate, students will be eligible for admission to the Graduate Diploma of Organisational Coaching and Leadership and receive credit for applicable subjects

To graduate students must satisfactorily complete 32 points.
