

DR WADE MACE

Dr Mace is a graduate of Waikato University with PhD in Chemistry. His first post-doc was in Ireland at the National Microelectronic Research Centre in Cork (NMRC, now the Tyndall Institute) synthesising organic receptors for incorporation into water sensor chips. Dr Mace then returned to New Zealand where he took on a position as a scientist developing the control release drug delivery devices for the rumen of cattle and sheep.
