<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	First or Second year  Bachelor of Social Science (Psychology)/Bachelor of Teaching (Secondary) double degree
<b>CAMPUS:</b>	Bathurst
<b>VALUE:</b>	\$2,000
<b>TENURE:</b>	One year
<b>CONDITIONS:</b>	<p><i>First preference</i> - Indigenous student. Supporting documentation is to be provided such as a letter by an Elder or other recognised person of the respective community.</p> <p><i>Second preference</i> – Student from the Western Region. Supporting documentation such as a rate notice, energy account or school record is to be provided.</p> <p><i>Third preference</i> – Highest achieving student entering second year of course</p> <p>Half the value of the scholarship will be presented at the scholarship ceremony with the balance payable at the beginning of spring session providing a grade point average of 5 or above is achieved and enrolment is ongoing.</p>

**HOW TO APPLY:** Applicants should complete the Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include copies of relevant supporting documents.

**NOTE:** Application forms can be both downloaded from the Scholarship website and completed manually, or an on-line Scholarship Application Form can be completed. During submission of your on-line application you should select all the scholarships that you wish to apply for and for which you meet the selection criteria.
