CountryPharm Scholarship – 2011

ELIGIBILITY:	First year Bachelor of Pharmacy
CAMPUS:	Orange or Wagga Wagga
VALUE:	\$10,000 (\$2,000 pa for first and second year and \$3,000 pa for third and fourth year).
ADDITIONAL BENEFITS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">* a laptop computer will be awarded to the scholarship recipient* fully paid attendance at PSA Pharmacy Expo during Graduate Year* return flights to oral Board Exam from Pharmacy location during Graduate Year
TENURE:	Four Years

CONDITIONS: First preference – Student who has undertaken the majority of high school education in central western NSW. Supporting documentation such as a school record is to be provided.

Second preference – If there is no suitable applicant from central western NSW, then a student from any location who agrees to the terms of the scholarship may be considered.

Successful applicant will be required to complete eight weeks paid employment during each year of the scholarship at a time that is mutually agreeable to both the donor and student.

Successful applicant will be required to complete a registration year and one year as a Registered Pharmacist working at one of the CountryPharm stores. The student and parents will be required to sign a contract prepared by CountryPharm.

If the successful applicant does not complete the Bachelor of Pharmacy course or does not fulfil the requirements of eight weeks paid employment each year during studies and two year's employment at the completion of studies, the money awarded through the scholarship is to be returned to CountryPharm.

\$1,000 will be presented at the scholarship ceremony with the second and subsequent instalments payable at the beginning of each session providing a credit grade point average is maintained and enrolment is ongoing.

HOW TO APPLY: Applicants should complete the Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include copies of relevant supporting documents.

NOTE: Only one on-line Scholarship Application Form should be completed. During submission of your on-line application you should select all the scholarships that you wish to apply for and for which you meet the selection criteria.
