Indyamarra Scholarships & Indyamarra Prizes – 2011

- ELIGIBILITY:** Any course in the fields of Education, Nursing and Health
Available for Indigenous students:
- Students completing their final year of study at any campus of Charles Sturt University are invited to apply for the Indyamarra Scholarships (at least 2 available).
 - Students studying in the second year of a three year course or in the third year of a four year course are invited to apply for the Indyamarra Prizes (several awards may be offered)
- CAMPUS:** Any
- VALUE:** **Scholarships** – at least \$3,000 each
Prizes – at least \$1,000
- TENURE:** One year
- CONDITIONS:** Applicants must;
- Indigenous student, from a NSW regional area and with a desire to work in areas to benefit the Koori Community. Supporting documentation is to be provided to show Indigenous heritage such as a letter by an Elder or other recognised person of the respective community.
 - Have a one page letter explaining your personal circumstances, financial situation, future goals (including Koori Community involvement) and aspirations should be included.
- A cheque will be presented to the scholarship and prize winners at the scholarship ceremony.

HOW TO APPLY: Applicants should complete the Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include copies of relevant supporting documents.

NOTE: Application forms can be both downloaded from the Scholarship website and completed manually, or an on-line Scholarship Application Form can be completed. During submission of your on-line application you should select all the scholarships that you wish to apply for and for which you meet the selection criteria.
