- ELIGIBILITY:** Third Year
Bachelor of Pharmacy
- CAMPUS:** Orange or Wagga Wagga
- VALUE:** \$5,000 per annum for final two years of the course
2 Scholarships are available
- TENURE:** Two years
- CONDITIONS:** Before applying, applicants should request further information about the scholarship by emailing Martin Phillips on mppharm@pacific.net.au.
- The successful students will have the unique opportunity to undertake a significant practicum experience in a regionally based Pharmacy Group. This will include Business Management along with the opportunity to work comprehensively with Patients and to apply the professional services that have been an integral part of Tertiary Training.
- Successful applicants will be required to complete a registration year and one year as a Registered Pharmacist working at Martin Phillips Pharmacy (successful students and parents will be required to sign a contract prepared by Martin Phillips Pharmacy agreeing to meet these conditions)
- If the successful applicants do not complete the Bachelor of Pharmacy course, the money awarded through the scholarships is to be returned to Martin Phillips Pharmacy.
- \$2,500 will be presented at the scholarship ceremony with a further \$2,500 at the beginning of each subsequent session providing a credit grade point average of 5 or above is achieved and enrolment is ongoing.
- HOW TO APPLY:** Applicants should complete the Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include copies of relevant supporting documents.
- NOTE:** Only one on-line Scholarship Application Form should be completed. During submission of your on-line application you should select all the scholarships that you wish to apply for and for which you meet the selection criteria.
