## WBC STRATEGIC ALLIANCE RURAL FINANCE SCHOLARSHIP - 2010

- ELIGIBILITY:** First year
- Bachelor of Business (Accounting)  
Bachelor of Business (Finance)
- CAMPUS:** Bathurst or Dubbo
- VALUE:** \$25,500 (\$8,500pa for three years of the course)
- TENURE:** Three years
- CONDITIONS:** The scholarship will be offered every three years.
- The successful applicant must reside within the Wellington, Blayney or Cabonne Council area and have completed the majority of their High School education in one of these Council areas. Supporting documentation such as a rate notice, energy account or school record is to be provided.
- The successful applicant will be required to sign a contract (to be prepared by WBC Strategic Alliance) to complete a minimum of one month and up to three months of unpaid work experience each year (date and duration to be confirmed with successful applicant and to include all three councils – Wellington, Blayney and Cabonne).
- There is a possibility that WBC Strategic Alliance will offer to cover accommodation and travel costs (successful applicant to confirm with WBC Strategic Alliance).
- There is also the possibility of employment with the WBC Strategic Alliance for the successful applicant at the end of their degree.
- \$2,500 will be presented at the scholarship ceremony with the second and subsequent instalments made at the beginning of each session providing a grade point average of 5 or above is achieved and enrolment is ongoing.
- HOW TO APPLY:** Applicants should complete the Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include copies of relevant supporting documents.
- NOTE:** Only one on-line Scholarship Application Form should be completed. During submission of your on-line application you should select all the scholarships that you wish to apply for and for which you meet the selection criteria.
