COUNTRY ENERGY SCHOLARSHIP - 2010

- ELIGIBILITY:** Any year
Any course
- CAMPUS:** Dubbo
- VALUE:** \$3,500 plus \$500 text book allowance
- TENURE:** One year
- CONDITIONS:** Student to be studying full-time internally or via distance education.

Student to be a resident of Country Energy North Western Region (including the centres Wanaaring, Brewarrina, Bourke, Louth, Walgett, Cobar, Coonamble, Coonabarabran, Nyngan, Warren, Gilgandra, Coolah, Dubbo and Mudgee). Supporting documentation is to be provided such as a rate notice, energy account or school records.
- HARDSHIP:** Applicant must be able to demonstrate financial hardship. To access the Hardship/Disability Form, which should be completed as part of the application, process please [click here](#).
- CONDITIONS:** \$1,750 plus the text book allowance will be presented at the scholarship ceremony with the balance payable at the beginning of second session providing a credit grade point average is achieved and enrolment is ongoing.
- HOW TO APPLY:** Applicants should complete the Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include copies of relevant supporting documents.
- NOTE:** Only one on-line Scholarship Application Form should be completed. During submission of your on-line application you should select all the scholarships that you wish to apply for and for which you meet the selection criteria.
