

Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarships – helping students reach their goals



Westwood Scholarships – 2011

ELIGIBILITY:	First, Second or Third Years Bachelor of Ecological Agricultural Systems – studying via internal or distance education mode.
CAMPUS:	Orange
VALUE:	3 scholarships value at \$5,000 each will be offered 1 x First Year 1 x Second Year (student who has completed 8 or more subjects) 1 x Third Year (student who has completed 16 or more subjects)
TENURE:	One Year

CONDITIONS:

First-year applicants must submit a two-page statement on why they have enrolled in Ecological Agriculture. An interview with the student will also be conducted to assess their enthusiasm for the notion of ecological agriculture and their previous contributions to Ecological Agriculture.

Second-year applicants will be required to submit a two-page statement on their current view of Ecological Agriculture. An interview will also be conducted which will give students the opportunity to express their passion for the notion of ecological agriculture and a desire to improve on previous results.

Third-year applicants will be required to make a written submission which reflects their current view of ecological agriculture. The student's overall development as reflected in their grades will be taken into account. Whilst not essential a desirable feature would include a portfolio of evidence re the graduate capabilities.

Past recipients of the Westwood scholarship will be eligible to apply, however any one student can hold the scholarship on a maximum of two occasions.

Applicant must be able to demonstrate financial hardship. To access the Hardship/Disability Form which should be completed as part of the application process, please [click here](#).

Half the value of the scholarship will be presented at the scholarship ceremony with the balance payable at the beginning of spring session providing a grade point average of 5 or above is achieved and enrolment is ongoing. This regulation can be waved by the Course Coordinator in consultation with the donor.

HOW TO APPLY: Applicants should complete the Charles Sturt Foundation Scholarship Application Form and include copies of relevant supporting documents.

NOTE: Only one on-line Scholarship Application Form should be completed. During submission of your on-line application you should select all the scholarships that you wish to apply for and for which you meet the selection criteria.
