- OPEN TO:** Second Year
- CAMPUS:** Any
- VALUE:** \$7,000.00
\$4,000 will be awarded in the first year; and
\$3,000 will be awarded in the second year.
- TENURE:** Two Years
- ELIGIBILITY:** Bachelor of Oral Health
- CONDITIONS:** Applicants will be required to;
- Demonstrate an interest in Aboriginal health, commitment to the improvement of oral health in Aboriginal communities and academic achievement in their first year of study based on a clear PASS level or higher.
 - Submit an application addressing the above selection criteria and providing any necessary supporting documentation.
 - Spend the funds on educational purposes including books, laptop, protective clothing and equipment;
 - Provide two progress reports to be tabled to the Bila Muuji Executive;
 - Attend a work placement for a minimum of one week at one of the Bila Muuji sites as part of the Bachelor of Oral Health elective placement program;
 - Complete a minimum of 12 months Graduate Work Placement with the Greater Western Area Health Therapy work. This placement will be based across Bila Muuji sites as Directed by GWAHS and Bila Muuji Executive.
- NOTE:** Half the value of the Scholarship will be presented at the Scholarship Ceremony, with the balance payable at the beginning of second session academic achievement in their first year of study based on a clear PASS level or higher and enrolment is ongoing.
