CONDITIONS:

- Applicant to reside within the Carrathool Shire Boundaries. Supporting documentation to be provided.
- Possess a sound academic record and be able to demonstrate a significant contribution to school or community activities.
- Preference may be given to applicants who express a desire to return to the Shire at the completion of their studies.

NOTE: The full value of the scholarship will be presented to the recipient at the scholarship ceremony. The recipient must report to the donor once Semester 1 grades are released, to inform the donor of their results showing they are achieving satisfactorily and their enrolment is ongoing
