ELIGIBILITY: Bachelor of Pharmacy

- The successful students will have the unique opportunity to further their comprehensive patient management skills, by undertaking a significant practicum experience in a regionally based NSW pharmacy group.
- The scholarship comes with an employment offer of an intern placement year and a subsequent newly registered employment year following the end of the pharmacy course. This career-orientated program will equip the newly registered with a range of business and professional practice skills in varied community pharmacy patient management settings.
