

2012 CSU FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Murrumbidgee Irrigation Cadetship



OPEN TO: Any Year in Environmental Science or Information Technology

CAMPUS: Any

VALUE: \$5,000 plus 10 weeks paid vacation work with Murrumbidgee Irrigation – to be paid in two equal amounts at the successful completion of each session

TENURE: One Year

ELIGIBILITY: Environmental Science or Information Technology

CONDITIONS

:

- Applicants must be an Australian citizen of hold permanent residency status, and be a resident of the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area.
- Applicants must ideally be able to demonstrate a credit average on application and ideally maintain a credit average for the duration of the cadetship.
- Applicants may be required to undertake 10 weeks' vacation work at Murrumbidgee Irrigation over a 12-month period (wages additional to cadetship payment). This is also dependent on the MI's ability to accommodate applicable vacation work.
- Applicants will be required to prepare and present a report on an agreed topic in a relevant format before being eligible for final cadetship payment.
- Applicants will be required to assist Murrumbidgee Irrigation to promote and publicize the program.
- The first half of the cadetship will be presented following the successful awarding of the cadetship with the balance payable at the completion of the next session provided that an acceptable level of attainment is achieved and enrolment is ongoing.

NOTE: The first half of the cadetship will be presented at the successful completion of the first session with the balance payable at the completion of the second session provided that an acceptable level of attainment is achieved and enrolment is ongoing.
