The Peter Andren Memorial Scholarship supports Charles Sturt University in its commitment to provide an enriching and supportive Student Experience for students.

OPEN TO: Any Year

CAMPUS: Bathurst

VALUE: Up to \$5,000

TENURE: Will depend on nature of the project.

ELIGIBILITY: Bachelor of Communication (Journalism); Bachelor of Sports Studies/Bachelor of Communication (Journalism) (double degree); Bachelor of Communication (Commercial Radio); Bachelor of Communication (Theatre Media)

CONDITIONS: The scholarship aims to encourage true investigative journalism, by providing funding for a project or proposal that explores a significant topic within our community or on a worldwide scale. The applicant must submit, along with their application, a brief summary of their proposal which includes;

- background information on the proposal;
- goals for the project;
- expected costs;
- a time frame for the project;
- and an explanation of why their chosen topic is significant.

The scholarship is open to all forms of media and the prize may be used in anyway the successful applicant sees fit (purchase of equipment, travel expenses, study costs etc).

Students must attach their project proposal as a separate document to their application.

NOTE: The full value of the scholarship will be presented to the recipient at the scholarship ceremony. The recipient must report to the donor once Semester 1 grades are released, to inform the donor of their results showing they are achieving satisfactorily and their enrolment is ongoing
