There are few journalists whose questions become folk lore. “Feeling a little embarrassed tonight at the blood that’s on your hands?” Is such a great example. Richard put that question to Bob Hawke on the day he ripped the Labor Party leadership from Bill Hayden.

It was Richard’s trademark style of interviewing that he cut through the complex and exposed the essence of an issue.

He spent half his journalistic life with the ABC and the other half with 60 Minutes, “the best job imaginable,” reporting from trouble zones across the world and being thrown out of many for his refusal to accept official propaganda.
