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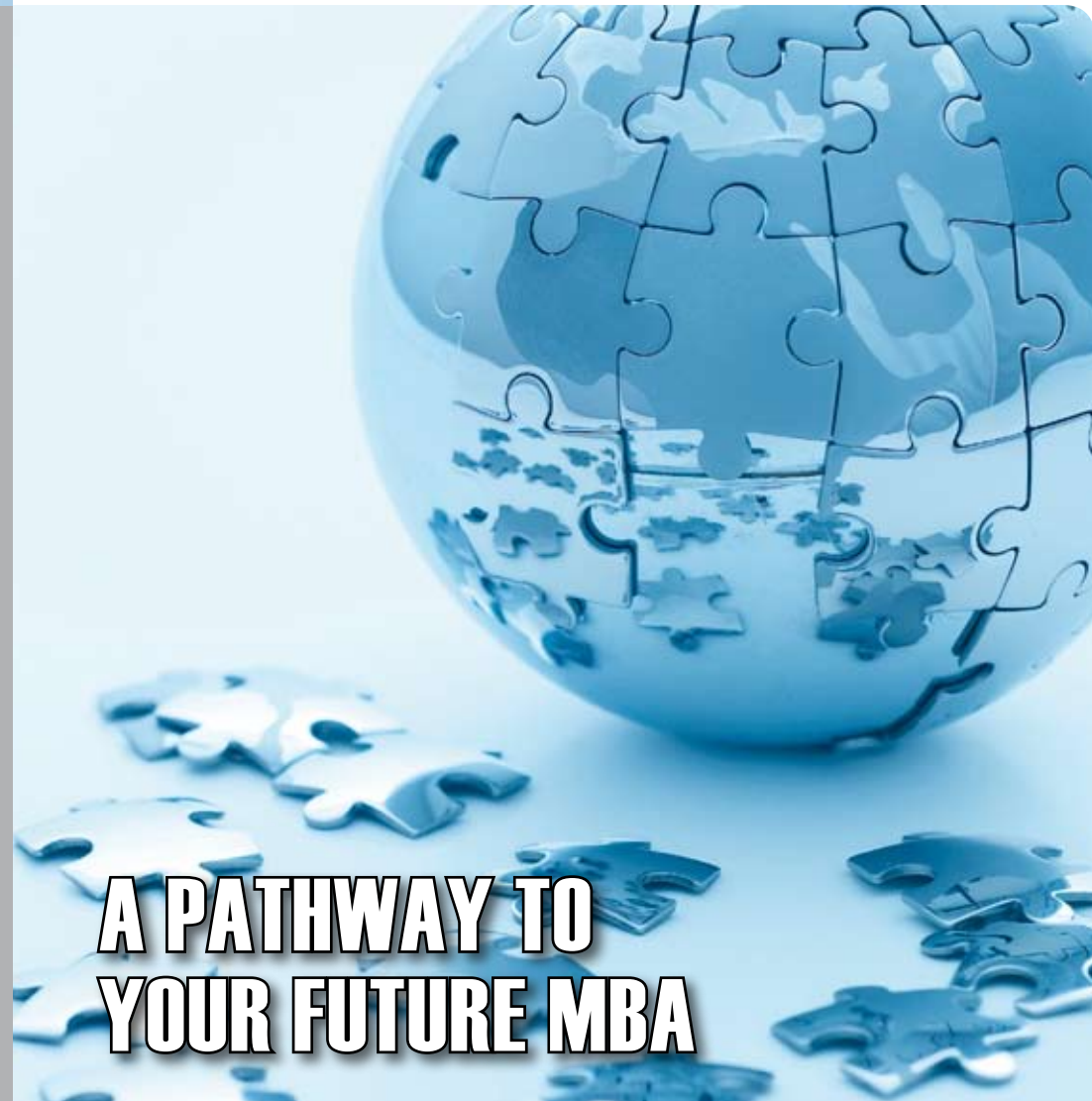

ABOUT THE COURSE

The Graduate Certificate in Commerce provides students with the opportunity to choose the subjects that best suit their particular career needs.

COURSE STRUCTURE

The course consists of four elective subjects aggregating to 32 subject points. The following requirements must be met:

- all subjects must be selected from the range of prescribed subjects offered by the Faculty of Business at Level 5 or equivalent
- students are not permitted to enrol in any subject which is similar to a subject already completed
- the student shall meet all prerequisite requirements.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants are required to have an undergraduate degree from a recognised tertiary institution and/or an equivalent professional qualification.

Applicants without a tertiary qualification may be admitted if they can demonstrate that they have a minimum of seven years appropriate professional/management work experience.

PATHWAY TO THE MBA

Students select any four subjects from a choice of around 80 postgraduate subjects in the Faculty of Business. Upon successful completion of the Graduate Certificate in Commerce, students may receive credit for up to four subjects in the MBA course. Students who choose the following four subjects will receive credit for the core subjects in the MBA course.

MGT501 Management Theory and Practice	MBA501 Management, People and Organisations
MKT501 Marketing Management	MBA503 Marketing for Managers
ACC501 Business Accounting and Finance	MBA504 Accounting and Financial Management
MGT510 Strategic Management	MBA508 Business Strategy

SUBJECT MATERIAL

Distance education study packages are self-contained, including study notes, readings, assessment tasks, and one prescribed textbook. Each subject requires approximately 10-15 hours per week of study time.

TRIMESTERS

The Graduate Certificate in Commerce is delivered via distance education on a trimester basis:

Trimester 1: January – April

Trimester 2: May – August

Trimester 3: September – November
